

Code of Conduct and Ethics for Snowsport England Members,

Snowsport England and its affiliated clubs expects the highest standards of all, its members, participating in Snowsport.

All to be mindful of the following:-

- Not use inappropriate language or gestures, including foul, sexist, abusive, racist or prejudicial language or tolerate it from others
- Display high standards of behaviour
- Not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination if witnessed
- Conduct themselves in a manner that takes all reasonable steps to protect their own safety and that of others
- Promote the positive aspects of snowsports and fair play
- Encourage all participants to respect Snowsport England staff, volunteers and officials
- Recognise good performance and not just good results
- Place the well-being and safety of the child above the development of performance
- Respect children's opinions when making decisions about their participation in snowsport
- Abide by Snowsport England's Policies (please see SSE company Rules and Regulations)
- Understand that any breach of SSE Policies may result in disciplinary action
- Not use the internet or social media to make derogatory remarks about other people involved in snowsports, SSE regions or clubs, or anything related to snowsports that could be interpreted as wrong, unkind or that could bring the sport into disrepute.
