Meetings/conference calls	A minimum of 3 times per year all minutes to be sent to SSE board within 14 days of the meeting and approved by committee 21 days

Purpose of the Committee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Production of an annual Freestyle plan for SSE board approval and implementation of approved plan (by end of October). • To ensure that all athletes are clear on the talent pathway and to ensure that no athletes are lost from the sport due to poor communication and processes. This committee is there to ensure SSE give as much support to every athlete with regards to their aspirations within freestyle skiing .
Committee objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop a clear talent pathway from grass roots to BSS • To organise and run freestyle events, if appropriate • To act as a source of advice on technical matters • Coordinate an events calendar • Put in place a structure and framework for clubs and facilities to develop their freestyle activities in line with SSE strategy • Train officials to ensure continuity of support of volunteers • Develop training resources accordingly • Communicate to regions and clubs on a regular basis and include them in decision making feedback when required • To publish clear pathways for coach progression within all freestyle disciplines • To develop and maintain freestyle coaching scheme in partnership with the coaching Technical Panel • To ensure that the SSE brand is kept at the forefront of every event • To liaise with other key committees/ regions/clubs where necessary
