

Restrictions to Snowsport Activity in England COVID-19 – Local Tiers

- This tables below outline an overview of the baseline restrictions for each tier of restrictions across England – for some areas, Local Authorities may impose additional restrictions that may further impact what snowsport activity can take place.
- Where activity is listed as permitted, this may still be subject to additional restrictions and protocols - facilities, coaches, participants, and officials should consult the Snowsport England guidance and the Government guidance before undertaking any activity.
